

## EVERGREEN CEMETERY FACT SHEET

- Established in 1856 as a private cemetery. City assumed ownership in 1944.
- 50+ Acres
- Approximately 4,000 spaces available for sale – See Fee Schedule
- Pre-need spaces can be purchased on a payment plan

Non-potable water for irrigation purposes is available Wednesday and Saturday on the following schedule:

7:00 am – 10:00 am

A sign is posted at entranceway if the system is not available due to repairs or burials. If you turn on a faucet and no water comes out, please turn back the handle to the “off” position. Otherwise, when the system comes back on line, water will run from the faucet.

A faucet by the office door may be used to fill containers with water. Since it is on the city-wide system, water is always available at this location.

- Sealed vaults required
- Perpetual Care consists of cutting, maintaining and trimming all grass areas, top dressing and annual fertilizing of all grass areas.
- Grounds Maintenance Contract - \$58,686.38/year
