

CALL FOR ENTRIES
Mind, Body, Soul Exhibition

The Thomas Center for the Arts is accepting entries for the *Mind, Body, Soul* exhibition that will be displayed from March 20 through May 9, 2010 in the Main Gallery. This exhibition is co-sponsored by Shands Arts in Medicine. It will focus on artwork that serves to encourage empathy, understanding, and awareness of the roles of arts in maintaining physical, mental and spiritual well-being. Artists are encouraged to submit works that demonstrate how art can act as a tool for connection and cooperation between people and as a part of the healing process. The goal is to show the importance of the relationship between art and health.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Artists must be Florida residents and artwork must be original.
- Drawing, painting, printmaking, photography, sculpture, fine crafts, digital media, and mixed media are eligible.
- Submissions must include a CD with up to 5 images of the proposed works (300dpi no more than 1 MB each) in .jpg format. For 3-dimensional work, two images per piece may be submitted.
- Entries must include an annotated identification list for works: artist name, title, date, medium, and dimensions (h x w x d)
- Please enclose an artist's statement and biography and/or résumé.
- A price/insurance value (one figure) must be included for each work. If work is not-for-sale (NFS), it must be indicated.
- The CD should be mailed with the identification list and a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) for notification/CD return.
- **POSTMARK DEADLINE for mailed submissions is Friday, January 22, 2009.** Hand-delivered applications must arrive by 5 PM on Friday, January 22, 2009.

SALES

The Gallery receives a 20% commission on artwork sold through the exhibition. All works must remain in the exhibition until the close of the show. Shipping is the responsibility of the artist. Full insurance coverage is door to door, from receipt of work in the facility until it leaves.
